



IBEW LOCAL 103 APPRENTICESHIP RWCU SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Overview

- 1. School Year: 2016 – 2017
- 2. Total Scholarships: \$5,000
- 3. Individual Scholarships: 10 @ \$500 Each (Quantity may be reduced, thus increasing \$ amount.)

Eligibility Requirements:

- 1. Must be a member, in good standing, of River Works Credit Union.
- 2. Must be a 1st, 2nd, 3rd or 4th year IBEW Local 103 apprentice, in good standing with IBEW Local 103 and the JATC.

Award Parameters:

- 1. Award of the scholarships will be primarily based upon school and work performance.
- 2. Recipients will be determined by the JATC and RWCU.
- 3. Scholarship monies will be transferred directly from RWCU to each recipients RWCU account, to be applied to any outstanding school balance. If no outstanding balance exists, overages may be withdrawn by the winner at his/her discretion.

Application Submission:

- 1. **Application must include an employer letter of recommendation.**
- 2. **Applications must be received by RWCU on or by Friday, July 29, 2016 at 4:00 pm.**
- 3. Applications must be submitted to RWCU at either:
 - a. Main Branch: 947 Western Avenue, Lynn, MA 01905
 - b. Delta-Wye Branch: 256 Freeport Street, Dorchester, MA 02122 (Inside IBEW Local 103 Union Hall)
- 4. Applicants must also submit a one-page essay on their aspiration as a future journeyman and how they think their career will contribute to charitable causes.
- 5. Application may be submitted either in person or by mail.
